


FLEXIBLE TRANSPORTATION FUND (FLEX FUND)

- Established by 68th Legislature
 - Provides State funds
 - Focused on improving out interconnected transportation infrastructure
- Two Programs Available to Local Public Agencies:
 - 25% Set Aside
 - Non-oil producing counties & townships
 - Partner Allocation
 - All counties, townships, cities, and Tribal Nations



FLEXIBLE TRANSPORTATION FUND



Set Aside

- Non-Oil Producing counties and townships
- Levy 18 or more mills

Partner Allocation

All other applications

FLEX FUND 25% SET ASIDE

- Non-oil producing counties and townships
- Organized Townships must levy 18 mills
- Approx. \$43M available
- Selected by Flex Fund Committee
- Projects that improve or maintain county and township paved and unpaved roads and bridges



FLEX FUND – PARTNER ALLOCATION

- Open to any City, County, Township, or Tribal Nation
- Projects and funding determined by NDDOT Director



FLEX FUND CRITERIA

Priority was given to projects that:

- Support Economic Development
- Improve Safety
- Support Complete Streets
- Improve the Multi-modal Transportation Infrastructure
- Improve a roadway restriction (height or weight limitation)
- Are innovative

Application Deadline: December 31, 2023

The Flexible Transportation Fund was established by the 68th Legislative Assembly to complement the Federal Aid Highway program and further support an interconnected transportation system in our great state. The funds will be used to Improve the transportation infrastructure on and off the state highway system, and to match local funds and federal discretionary grant funds that may become available.


The Flex Fund is comprised of two programs:

- 1. 25% Set-Aside open to non-oil producing counties and townships.
- 2. Partner Allocation open to any City, County, Township, or Tribal Nation in North
